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| Appellation: | Santa Rita Hills |
| Vineyards: | John Sebastiano Vineyard; 100 acres of Pinot Noir planted on 48 blocks on the eastern edge of the SRH appellation |
| Clone(s): | Block 19B (2.31 acres) Clone 2A / Block 25A (2.71 acres) Clone 667 / Block 34 (3.57 acres) Clone 115 |
| Harvest: | September 30, 2010 |
| Yields: | Clone 2A -1.34 tons per acre (71%) / Clone 115- 0.24 tpa (19%) / Clone 667- 0.16 tpa (10%) |
| Crush: | Whole berry destemmed into small open top fermenters |
| Innoculum: | Bourgogne RC 212 after a 4 day cold maceration |
| Fermentation: | 12 day active, with punchdowns 2 times daily |
| Barrel Regime: | 9 months in 2 nd & 3 rd fill French oak Burgundy barrels |
| Racking: | Without O ₂ , once April 2011, then August 2011 prior to bottling |
| TA: | 0.68 g/100ml |
| Alc: | 15% |
| Ph: | 3.98 |
| Bottling: | August 8, 2011 without fining or filtration |
| Production: | 250 cases |
| Retail: | \$48 |
