Vineyard:	La Encantada
Clone(s):	Dijon 115 (Block 19) Dijon 667 (Block 12N)
Harvest:	Night harvested by hand on October 2, 2011
Yields:	1.6 to 2.3 tons per acre
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed into small open top tanks 5 day cold maceration
Innoculum:	Borgogne RC 212
Fermentation:	8 day active, with punchdowns 2 times a day
Barrel regime:	16 months in French oak 228L barrels, 60% new
Racking:	Without oxygen, once spring 2011, then again prior to bottling early 2012
Bottling:	Without fining or filtration, March 6, 2012
T.A:	0.67 g/100ml
PH:	3.51
Production:	270 cases
