Appellation:	Santa Maria Valley
Vineyard:	Julia's B3 & B4
Clone(s):	Pommard 4
Harvest:	By hand, B4 on Sept 13 and B3 on Sept 17
Yields:	Around 2/5 tons per acre
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed into small, open top fermenters
Innoculum:	After 4 day cold maceration, B4 w/Ady-RC 212 & B3 w/Ady RA17
Fermentation:	14 day active with hand punchdown 2 times daily
Barrel regime:	16 months in Francois Frere tight grained French oak barrels, 45% new
Racking:	Without oxygen, once early Spring 2011, then late winter 2012 prior to bottling.
Bottling:	March 6, 2012
Alcohol:	14.7%
T.A:	0.68 g/100mls
PH:	3.56
Production:	600 cases
