



## 2011 Pinot Noir, Melville Vineyard

Appellation:	Santa Rita Hills
Vineyard:	Melville Estate "C" block
Clone(s):	Dijon 115 & 777
Harvest:	By hand, September 26, 2011
Yields:	Around 2 tons per acre
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed into small, open-top fermenter
Innoculum:	Bourgogne RC212 after 5 days of cold maceration
Fermentation:	10 day active , with punchdowns 2 times daily
Barrel regime:	100% French oak, 65% new.-16 month aging
Racking:	Without pumping, once April 2012, then prior to bottling March 2013
Bottling:	March 18, 2013 without fining or filtration
Alcohol:	14.2% by volume
T.A:	0.68 g/100ml
PH:	3.58
Production:	150 cases
