

2011 Pinot Noir, John Sebastiano Vineyard

Appellation: Santa Rita Hills

Vineyards: John Sebastiano Vineyard, 48 distinct blocks of Pinot Noir

Clone(s): 47% Wadensvil (2A); 38% Dijon 115, 15% Dijon 667

Harvest: By hand, September 10, 2011

Yields: 0,25 to 0.96 tons per acre

Crush: Whole berry destemmed into small, open top fermenters

Innoculum: ADY-Assmanhausen, 3001 and RC212 after 3-5 day cold maceration

Fermentation: 10-14 day active, with punch downs 2 times daily

Barrel Regime: 16 months in 100% Orion French oak barrels, 60% new

Racking: Without pumping, once April 2012, then prior to bottling March 2013

Alc: 15% by volume

TA: 0.6 g/100ml

Ph: 3.85

Bottling: Without fining or filtration, March 18, 2013

Production: 220 cases
