Clone(s):	Entav 174 (70%) and Entav 877 (30%)
Harvest:	By hand on October 11 & 12, 2011
Yields:	3.0 tons per acre (174) & 1.0 ton per acre (877)
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed into open top fermenters, 4 day cold cold maceration
Innoculum:	RP15 (Rockpile) and L2056 (Rhône)
Fermentation:	12 day active, with punch downs 2 times daily
Barrel regime:	16 months in 500 liter Hungarian oak puncheons, 60% new
Racking:	Once late winter 2012, then again prior to bottling Spring 2013
Bottling:	Without fining or filtration on March 19, 2013
Alcohol:	14.2% alc
PH:	3.59
T.A	0.63 g/100ml
Production:	460 cases
