Vineyard:	Tinaquaic Vineyard
Clone(s):	Entav 174, Entav 470, Durrell field selection
Harvest:	By hand, October 28 & 29, 2011
Yields:	Low (1-1.5 tons per acre)
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed into open top fermenters. 4 day cold maceration
Innoculum:	L2056 & D254
Fermentation:	15 day active, with punch downs 2 times daily
Barrel regime:	16 months in French and Hungarian oak barrels, 50% new
Racking:	Once late winter 2012, then again prior to bottling Spring 2013
Bottling:	Without fining or filtration on March 19, 2013
Alcohol:	13.8% alc
PH:	3.77
T.A:	0.62 g/100ml
Production:	350 cases
