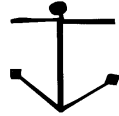

2012 Pinot Noir John Sebastiano Vineyard

Appellation:	Sta. Rita Hills
Vineyard:	John Sebastiano Vineyard ~ Blocks 19b, 25a, and 34
Clone(s):	38% Wadensvil (2A); 42% Dijon 115; 20% Dijon 667
Harvest:	At Night, August 31 ~ September 17, 2012
Yields:	Average 3.0 TPA (2.5 ppv)
Crush:	Whole berry destemmed into small, open top fermenters
Innoculum:	ADY & 3001; and RC212 & RA17 after 3-5 day cold maceration
Fermentation:	10-14 day active, with punch downs 2 times daily
Barrel Regime:	17 months in 100% French oak barrels, medium toast, tight grain – 33% new
Racking:	Without pumping, once February 2013, then prior to bottling March 2014
Alc:	14.0% by volume
TA:	0.58 g/100ml
pH:	3.85
Bottling:	Without fining or filtration, March 11, 2014
Production:	1,500 cases
